- Play will be from the Blue tees for the Senior/Open Division approximately 6500 yds, and from the White tees for the Super-Senior and Legends Divisions approximately 6000 yds.
- USGA Rules Apply
 - o If you have a doubt as to how to proceed play a second ball (Rule 3-3). Before proceeding under this rule announce to your fellow competitors your intention to do so and select which ball you wish to count if the rules permit. Report to the committee that you played a second ball and the details before certifying your score with the official scorer.
- Format is Two-Man Team Best Ball.
- Pace of Play: Keep up with the group in front of you. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- Measuring Devices (including GPS devices) are allowed if the device measures only distance
- Trophies will be awarded to the Champions in the Senior/Open Division only
 - o Gift certificates for The Piedmont Club pro-shop will be awarded
 - o Ties breakers for gift certificates: Back 9 score, last 6, last 3, last 1, etc.
- In the event of dangerous or severe weather, the tournament committee may adjust the competition to less than 18 holes. <u>Discontinuance of Play</u>: When play is suspended for a dangerous situation, players must discontinue play immediately. Players must not resume play until the Committee has ordered resumption of play. All practice areas shall be closed until the Committee has declared them open. Penalty for breach of rule *Disqualification*. NOTE: A player has the right to stop play if they think lightning threatens them, even though the Committee may not have authorized it specifically by signal.
