- The field is divided into 4 divisions based on the youngest player on each 2-man team. Amateurs (age 49 and under), Super-Seniors (age 65+) and Legends (age 70+) will play the Blue-Red combination of nines. Seniors (age 50+) will play the White-Blue combination of nines. Both players on the team will play from the tees assigned to that division. Amateurs will play from the Black tees at about 6650 yds. Seniors will play from the Blue tees at about 6300 yds. Super-Seniors will play from the White tees at about 5900 yds. Legends will play from the Green tees at about 5300 yds.
- **USGA Rules Apply**
 - o If you have a doubt as to how to proceed play a second ball (Rule 3-3). Before proceeding under this rule announce to your fellow competitors your intention to do so and select which ball you wish to count if the rules permit. Report to the committee that you played a second ball and the details before certifying your score with the official scorer.
- Format is Two-Man Team Best Ball.
- Pace of Play: Keep up with the group in front of you. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- The paper scorecards are the official score for each team. Swap cards within each group so that you are not keeping score for your own team. The scorecard must show the actual score used for the player making that score. Please ensure there are two signatures on the scorecard before turning it in.
- We will be using live scoring electronically using GolfGenius. This will allow the leaderboard to be viewed if desired during play and speed up scoring once play is completed. Each group needs one volunteer to enter the scores on their phone. If your team is tied for the lead in the Amateur or Senior Division for the championship when play is completed, do not put your clubs away and prepare for a playoff to determine the winning team.
- Measuring Devices (including GPS devices) are allowed if the device measures only distance
- Trophies will be awarded to the Champions in the Amateur and Senior Divisions only
 - Gift certificates for Army Navy Country Club pro-shop will be awarded
 - Ties breakers for gift certificates: Back 9 score, last 6, last 3, last 1, etc.
- In the event of dangerous or severe weather, the tournament committee may adjust the competition to less than 18 holes. Discontinuance of Play: When play is suspended for a dangerous situation, players must discontinue play immediately. Players must not resume play until the Committee has ordered resumption of play. All practice areas shall be closed until the Committee has declared them open. Penalty for breach of rule - Disqualification. NOTE: A player has the right to stop play if they think lightning threatens them, even though the Committee may not have authorized it specifically by signal.
