Format: 36-hole Individual medal play: Amateur Division, Senior Division, Super-Senior Division, and Legends Division. *There will be no cut after Day 1; all participants will be able to play on Day 2.*

** You must designate on the online entry form which Division you wish to play- *Amateur Division (Age 49 and under), Senior Division (age 50 or over), Super-Senior Division (age 65 or over), Legend (Division) (age 70 and over)*. The course is a par 70 layout. Amateur Division will play at approx. 6315 yds (Black tees). Senior Division will play at approx. 6058 yds (Blue tees). Super-Senior Division will play at approx. 5625 yds (White tees). Legend Division will play at approx. 5300 yds (White/Red combo tees).

Champion is the aggregate low gross score for thirty-six holes in the Amateur Division, Senior Division, Super-Senior Division and Legend Division. A play-off will determine the Champion in the event of a tie. Ties for other places in each division will be determined by a match of cards as described in Notice to Competitors (USGA method of last 9, last 6, last 3, last hole). The committee may shorten or reschedule the event due to inclement weather.

This is a VSGA tier 3 points event – Amateur Division, Senior Division and Super-Senior Division (75 points for the Division winner, points awarded to top 10 finishers). No points will be awarded for Legend Division.

Entry Fee: \$175. The fee covers golf, range balls and cart for both days, awards, and prizes. Based on a field of 100 players, the prize pool (pro shop gift certificates) will be about \$6000 and will be paid out over 33-40 percent of the field by division. We will confirm receipt of entries by email. Please let us know if you have not received confirmation by Thursday, September 17th.

Eligibility: Open to all male amateur players who are members of a VSGA club in Virginia, with a current USGA handicap index at that club, and who play the majority of the time at those clubs. **(Residence in Virginia is not required.)** All entries are subject to approval by the governing committee.

Dress Code: Participants must adhere to host club dress code.

Practice Rounds: Practice rounds for the tournament are available for a fee of \$50 including a cart. Practice round tee times will be available between 3:00 and 3:24 pm on **Sept 2, 3, 10, 15 and 16**. Call the pro shop (at **703-522-7091**) five days ahead of time to get your tee time. Do not just show up and ask to play a practice round. When you call, please make sure you indicate it is for a practice round for the event.
