



Dear NOVA Amateur Competitors,

*The Members and Staff of Washington Golf & CC are delighted that you will be a Guest of our club. Our facilities, including our golf course and range, have undergone substantial renovations which were completed in 2019. We are excited that you plan to enjoy them with us. Our intention is to provide a first-class golf experience at Washington Golf & CC. The staff is committed to making your visit a pleasurable one and with that in mind we would like to share with you some guidelines to make your visit more enjoyable.*

### **General Guidelines for your visit**

**Arrival & Parking & Driving Range:** Washington Golf & CC is located at 3017 N. Glebe Rd. Our campus extends to both sides of Glebe Rd thus parking is available on either side of Glebe Rd. There is limited parking along Rock Spring Rd (intersection of Glebe Rd. & Rock Spring Rd.) near the golf shop building. There is a bag drop on the east side of Glebe Rd near the front entrance of the clubhouse. Our staff will greet you as you drop your clubs before parking. We suggest arriving 30 minutes before your starting time to allow our staff to assist you with any needs.

**Driving Range:** Our newly renovated driving range, The Turn, is located at the end of Rock Spring Rd. If warm up is required it is recommended to drive and park to warm up. There are 42 parking spots available at a first come first serve basis. However, be sure to exit the range at a minimum of 20 minutes before your scheduled starting time. (See Map Below) Please call the golf shop (703) 522-7091 for any questions or clarity.

**Pace of Play:** A round of golf at Washington Golf & CC takes four hours. Please be prepared to maintain this standard by keeping within 300 yards of the group in front of you. Ready golf is always encouraged. Our on-course staff as well as your host can help with any questions regarding local rules.

**Attire:** Our dress code requires collared shirts or mock turtlenecks, slacks or shorts. Shorts are to be no more than two inches above the knee. Jeans and other denim clothing are not allowed on the golf course or practice facility. Gentlemen are required to remove hats while in the clubhouse. Hats should be worn forward and shirts tucked in. No golf shoes are allowed in the clubhouse except in the locker rooms.

**Golf Course:** Please use the sand mix provided on your cart to repair all divots in both the fairway and the rough. Sand mix is also provided for those carrying their bags. Please repair all ball marks, rake all bunkers, leave the rakes outside the bunker and kindly remove sand from your spikes upon leaving the bunkers. Also please exit all bunkers on the lower side farthest from the green. Specific cart restrictions will be provided on your day of play, but always enter the rough or fairway at least ten yards past the forward tee. We prefer you follow the

scatter rule before exiting the fairway as designated by the small brown stakes with red tips on either side of the hole.

**Smoking Policy:** The entire indoor facility of WGCC is smoke free, with the exception of the designated area in locker rooms. Smoking is permissible on the golf course. Please be courteous and dispose of cigarette and cigar butts in proper garbage receptacles.

**Cell Phones:** The use of cellular phones and other electronic communications devices are not permitted in any dining areas or common areas frequented by Members. Please be courteous and use your cell phone outside or in a private area. Please have your cell phone on vibrate on the course. Cell phones may only be used for emergency purposes.
