



WELCOME TO THE 2026 (47th) NORTHERN VIRGINIA AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP and (43rd ANNUAL) NORTHERN VIRGINIA SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

DEFENDING CHAMPIONS: Anton Krecic, Amateur Division; Jeff Klatt (Senior Division); Keith Morgan (Super-Senior Division); Joe Wallenfelsz (Legends Division)

- Play will be from the **Black tees – Amateur Div** ~ 6315 yds; **Blue tees - Senior Div** ~ 6254 yds.; **White tees-- Super Seniors** ~ 6058 yds.; **Red tees – Legends** ~ 5625 yds.
- USGA Rules Apply – See Local Rules Sheet
 - If you have a doubt as to how to proceed play a second ball (Rule 20). Before proceeding under this rule announce to your fellow competitors your intention to do so and select which ball you wish to count if the rules permit. Report to the committee that you played a second ball and the details *before submitting your scorecard*.
- Format is Individual Stroke Play (gross)
- Please notify us before departing the course after Day 1 play Monday if you do not intend to play on Day 2 Tuesday.
- Pace of Play: Please keep up with the group in front of you. Course marshals will be requesting groups out of position to speed up play. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- Measuring Devices (including GPS devices) are allowed if the device measures only distance
- Trophy will be awarded to the overall Champion (Amateur, Senior, Super-Senior and Legend Divisions). Amateur Champion will be inscribed on the Henry Kerfoot Trophy.
 - Gift certificates for the WG&CC pro-shop will be awarded at the end of 36 holes by division.
 - Playoff for Championship (1st Place Overall Amateur, Senior, Super-Senior divisions and Legend)
 - Ties breakers for gift certificates: Back 9 score, last 6, last 3, last 1, etc.
- In the event of dangerous or severe weather, the tournament committee may adjust the competition to less than 36 holes.
 - ***LIGHTENING KILLS!*** Discontinuance of Play: When play is suspended for a dangerous situation by sounding the warning system horn, players **must discontinue play immediately**. Players must not resume play until the Committee has ordered resumption of play. All practice areas shall be closed until the Committee has declared them open. **Penalty for breach of rule – Disqualification.** NOTE: *A player has the right to stop play if they think lightning threatens them, even though the Committee may not have authorized it specifically by signal.*
